



ORDER

No. 98, dated 16.07.2018

ON

DETERMINATION OF THE COORDINATORS GROUP TO IMPLEMENT THE ACTION PLAN OF THE NATIONAL STRATEGY FOR DIASPORA 2018-2024

Pursuant to paragraph 3, Article 102 of the Constitution, and Article 12 of Law no. 9000, dated 30.1.2003, "On the organization and functioning of the Council of Ministers", of Decision no. 259, dated 09.05.2018 of the Council of Ministers "On the Approval of the National Strategy for Diaspora 2018-2024 and the Action Plan",

I HEREBY ORDER:

1. Definition of the Coordinator's Group for the Implementation of the National Action Plan for Diaspora 2018-2024 adopted by the DCM no. 259, dt. 09. 05. 2018, "On the Adoption of the National Diaspora Strategy 2018-2024 and the Action Plan".
2. The Coordinator Group is chaired by the State Minister for Diaspora.
3. The institutions responsible for the implementation of the Action Plan shall be represented at the level of the Deputy Minister, as well as by 2 (two) other representatives, specialists in the field and shall be, as follows:
 - Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs;
 - Ministry of Finance and Economy;
 - Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth;
 - Ministry of Culture;
 - Ministry of Tourism and Environment;
 - Ministry of Interior;
 - Ministry of Justice;
 - Ministry of Health and Social Protection;
 - Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development.



Minister of State for Protection of Entrepreneurship, to be represented by the Director of the Cabinet. The Academy of Sciences, INSTAT and National Diaspora Agency will be represented by their Directors.

4. Coordinators are responsible for coordinating the work to implement Action Plan measures in the institution they represent.
5. Group of Coordinators is responsible for:
 - a) Follow up and implement the measures set out in the Action Plan of the National Diaspora Strategy 2018-2024.
 - b) Determining the detail of costs and indicators for all the measures provided for in the action plan.
6. Coordinators must meet not less than once a month and whenever necessary, at chairman's announcement.
7. Experts from other structures, such as non-profit organizations, international bodies, universities and personalities may also be invited to meetings of the Coordinator's Group.
8. The heads of the institutions mentioned in point 3 of this order shall be assigned to appoint their representatives within 5 (five) days from its entry into force.
9. State Minister for Diaspora, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Finance and Economy, Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth, Ministry of Culture, Ministry of Tourism and Environment, Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Justice the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, the State Minister for the Protection of Entrepreneurship, INSTAT, the Academy of Sciences, the National Agency for Diaspora, to follow up the implementation of this order.

This order shall enter into force immediately
